Kissimmee Prairie Preserve State Park encompasses and protects the largest remaining tract of Florida Dry Prairie, an ecosystem that occurs only in Florida. Dry Prairie is a floristically diverse ecosystem and hosts many pollinator species, notably butterflies

The North American Butterfly Association's publication *American Butterflies* highlighted Kissimmee Prairie Preserve as a 'definitive destination' in the spring 2003 issue. The article considers the Preserve to be one of the best locations in Florida for observing butterflies, especially skippers. More than half of the breeding butterfly fauna in Florida can be observed within the Preserve.

Currently, the Preserve checklist is at 88 documented species, compiled through the efforts of Florida naturalists Linda and Buck Cooper. Visiting butterfly enthusiasts are encouraged to enjoy their visit and to submit any *photographed* sightings of species not on the checklist to the Preserve biologist.

The order used for this checklist follows that found in the North American Butterfly Association's *Checklist & English Names of North American Butterflies*, Second Edition, 2001.

Numbers (1-12) indicate months butterfly species have been observed in the Preserve. 'R' indicates the species is rare in the Preserve
