Thank you for your interest in The Barnacle Historic State Park. We are delighted that your organization wishes to visit The Barnacle. The Barnacle hosts group tours on Wednesday and Thursday by reservation. Please call the park office at 305-442-6866 to book a tentative date at least two weeks prior to your tour.

Complete the attached reservation form, noting any special needs so that assistance will be available upon your arrival. Prior to your visit, fax the reservation form to 305-442-6872 or mail to The Barnacle Historic State Park, 3485 Main Highway, Coconut Grove, Florida 33133.

If the group is arriving early or late, please notify the park as soon as possible as a park staff member will meet your group at the front gate. If there is no staff member at the gate, follow the instructions on the call box at the driveway gate. Once the group enters the park, the gates will be locked. If someone must leave the park, a staff member will escort you out.

Groups of up to 30 participants get a tour of the hammock, House, and Boathouse. Groups with 31-60 participants get a tour of the hammock, Boathouse, and outdoor interpretation of the House. Due to room sizes groups of this size will not have access to the interior of the House.

Your group may enjoy a picnic in the park, but what you carry in must be carried out as we are not equipped with commercial trash disposal facilities. There is no on-site parking available and you will want to advise your group to dress appropriately for the weather and walking.

If your plans change, please call the park as soon as possible so another group may enjoy the opportunity to visit The Barnacle.
