Position	Construction and Maintenance
General Description	Maintenance and repair of public and service/storage facilities and grounds around the park.
Assigned Tasks	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Specialized maintenance work such as carpentry, plumbing, electrical repair, small engine repair, welding, concrete work, and heavy equipment operation.• Plan and execute projects• Structure repair• Grounds Keeping and Landscaping
Qualifications and Skills	Basic knowledge of various fields of maintenance and construction which include but are not limited to: Carpentry, Electrical, Plumbing, Painting, Small Engine Repair, and Grounds Keeping. Knowledge of safety procedures required during maintenance.
Standards and Performance	This is a field position. The volunteer must be in good physical condition and be able to work outside in strenuous conditions for long periods of time in variable weather. Must meet the minimum number of hours required each week. Must submit monthly log of hours worked each month. Must be able to present oneself in a professional manner to the public when encountered. Must be trained in and adhere to all Florida Park Service Safety and Customer Service Procedures and convey an understanding of our mission statement to the public and to fellow staff members. Must adhere to the volunteer uniform standards as designated by supervisor. Must be able to work independently and with staff and other volunteers effectively.
Hours Required	Host Volunteers: 20 hours/week per site minimum Daily Volunteers: no minimum
