## Ichetucknee Springs State Park



### About the Park:

The crystal waters of the Ichetucknee River flow six miles through shade hammocks and wetlands before they join the Santa Fe River. Enjoy tubing, paddling, snorkeling, scuba diving, swimming, hiking, wildlife viewing and a picnic area. A concession offers refreshments and outdoor products. Canoe and kayak rentals are available.

### Current Successes:

- Installed interpretive signage along the Discovery Trail
- Conducted Water Lettuce workdays. Removed over 1 ton of water lettuce – greatly enhancing the river ecosystem
- South Takeout Restroom Project complete!
- Completed timber thinning and fire break preparation work at McCormick Sink.
- Added additional Fall interpretive programming and events.
