What does it mean to be a G.I.R.L. in Florida State Parks?

G.I.R.L. stands for Go-Getter, Innovator, Risk Taker and Leader. Below are definitions of these traits and examples of activities you could do in Florida State Parks. Match the traits with examples by selecting the correct letter.

Go-Getter

Being a go-getter means being bold, honest, and determined to succeed. When problems arise, go-getters are the first to **get organized**!

Innovator

Being an innovator means thinking outside the box and looking for a creative way to take action in your community. Many <u>scientists</u> are innovators.

Risk Taker

Risk takers are courageous and strong. They are keen to <u>try new things</u> and embrace the unfamiliar.

Leader

Leaders are confident, responsible, and committed to changing the world. Leaders **inspire others** by sharing their passion!
