Rules and Regulations

- · Hours: The park opens at 8 a.m. and closes at sunset year round.
- · Key Pad Lock: The front gate is locked at sunset. Please do not give the combination to anyone or allow anyone to follow you in.
- · Reservation Procedures: Camping reservations can be made 7 days per week, up to 11 months in advance by calling 800-326-3521 or TDD 888-433-0287. Reservations can also be made online by visiting www.reserve.floridastateparks.org
- · Pets: Pets are permitted in campground, parking lots, trails and paved roadways, but are not permitted on beaches, in pavilions or buildings. Pets must be on a 6-feet or shorter hand-held leash at all times. Pets cannot be tied off or left unattended. Campers are required to pick up pet waste. Waste bags are provided.
- · Wildlife: For your safety and the safety of the wildlife, do not feed the animals!
- Beach Dunes: Please do not walk on/ over any dunes or dune vegetation. This destroys critical habitat for endangered wildlife and severely weakens the shorelines against erosion.
- · Vegetation: Do not tie or hang anything on or in trees. Campsite set-up may also not encroach on vegetation. The seemingly insignificant act of tying ropes, wires or lanterns to trees or living plants will damage and eventually kill the plants. Please do not walk over dunes and vegetation.
- Collection of downed wood is prohibited.
- Alcoholic Beverages: Alcoholic beverages are permitted in camping units only. Open consumption or display is prohibited.
- Garbage: For your convenience, dumpsters and a recycling center are located just outside of the campground loop as you enter/leave Shady Pines.
- Gray Water: It is illegal to dump gray water or sewage on the ground. Connect to the sewer line at your campsite to empty your tanks.
- Speed Limit: Please observe posted speed limits.
- Site Occupancy: All equipment and vehicles must fit within the campsite. Avoid parking on grass or in buffer areas.
- · Appliances: Major appliances that are kept outside the camping rig or which require a separate hook up are not permitted.
- Water Use/Conservation: Do not wash any cars, trucks, RVs, trailers, boats or jet skis.
- · Turtle Season (May August): Restrict beach activity and lights on the beach.
- Fishing Licenses: A saltwater fishing license may be required.
- Restricted Areas: Please observe restricted areas. Special permit is required to access the Wilderness Preserve.
