
### **Park Rules**

- Check the flag warning system. A red flag means high hazard and double red flags means danger. The water is closed for double red flags.
- Maximum of two vehicles allowed per site. Vehicle parking pass must be displayed in windshield.
- Trash must be placed in dumpster.
- Do not leave any belongings or trash on beach.
- Help us conserve water RVs, vehicles, and boats may not be washed. Camping
  dishes must be washed in large sink near laundry areas. Swimming pools are
  NOT allowed.
- Alcoholic beverages prohibited on the beach and in all public use areas.
- Speed limit in park is 15 mph. When entering the park, all campers and guests must stop at the ranger station window.
- Open ground fires are not allowed. Please keep all fire in contained fire rings. No cutting or collecting of live or dead wood.
- ALL camping equipment, vehicles and personal belongings MUST fit within campsite boundaries.
- Please use designated pathways and dune crossovers to ensure protection of our natural communities. Do not make trails between campsites.
- It is unlawful to remove, destroy, deface or dig on any park property. This includes attaching any objects such as ropes to trees or cutting firewood.
- Bicyclists are to observe all traffic laws. Florida law requires children under 16 to wear helmets while bicycling.





# **Campground Information**

- All sites have full hook-ups.
- Speed limit in campground is 10 mph.
- Each campsite is limited to eight persons and one camping unit plus one small tent.
- All vehicles, campers and boat trailers must be parked on shell rock pads.
- Tents must be within 30 feet of pad.
- Each site may have one extra car, provided it fits on shell pad. Extra vehicle parking is available in the day-use parking lot.
- Campfires/cooking fires are only allowed in ground grills. Please extinguish fires when you are done.
- A garbage dumpster, dump station provided for your convenience.
- Children younger than 17 are to remain in campsite after dark unless accompanied by an adult.

# **Pets**

- Pets are not permitted on the beaches, boardwalks or park buildings.
- Pets must be well-behaved, confined or leashed, under the control of the owner at all times. Leashes may not exceed 6 feet.
- Do not leave tethered pets for more than 30 minutes. Please observe the park's quiet hours.
- Pet owners are required to pick up after their pets and properly dispose of all pet droppings in trash.
- Any pet that is noisy, dangerous, intimidating or destructive must be boarded outside the park.




