Welcome

Campers, please check in with Camp Host upon arrival.

Camp rules and guidelines:

- Camping is allowed only in sleeping platforms and designated areas.
- Fires are only permitted in designated fire rings and grills.
- State Park rules prohibit collecting firewood from the surrounding area.
 - See camp host to purchase firewood (subject to availability); \$6.00 per bundle.
- Food preparation and open flames, including candles and camp stoves, are not allowed under structures (sleeping platforms, pavilions, etc.).
- No pets are allowed in any buildings, platforms or platform areas.
- Pets must be kept on a 6 foot leash (maximum) and cannot be left unattended. They must be confined in your sleeping accommodation overnight. In this case, the only accommodation they can be in is your tent, in a designated camping spot.
- All vegetation in State Parks is protected; please, no hanging of lanterns, clothes lines, trash bags, etc. from trees or vegetation.
- Alcohol is permitted only at your camp site (sleeping platform or designated primitive site);
- Alcohol consumption is prohibited in common areas including walkways, restrooms, pavilions, group campfire circles, and beaches.
- Fireworks are not allowed on park property.
- If you have not made a reservation, please check with camp host for availability.

Remember to be a courteous camper: Please leave the camp in better condition than you found it.
