## Sebastian Fishing Museum and Gift Shop

Open 10:00 - 4:00 daily. Experience Florida's commercial fishing history. Video, historic pictures, and exhibits show how the commercial fishing industry began in the late 1800s and helped make Sebastian what it is today. The museum is dedicated to the Sembler, Smith, and Judah families who pioneered commercial fishing in this area.

### McLarty Treasure Museum and Gift Shop

Open 10:00 - 4:00 daily. In 1715, a fleet of Spanish treasure ships laden with gold and silver was returning to Spain from Mexico and Peru. As they passed our coast, a hurricane wrecked nearly all of the ships in the pounding surf near the McLarty Museum, which was constructed at the site of the Spanish salvage camp. Exhibits interpret the history of this event and salvage attempts, and a display of some of the recovered treasure.

### Pets (allowed in campground and paths only. No pets on jetty or in beach, tide pool, or swimming areas.)

- Pets must be leashed (leash less than six feet in length) or under physical control at all times.
- Tethered pets must not be unattended for more than 30 minutes. Quiet hours are 11:00 p.m.-7:00 a.m.
- Owners must pick up after their pets and properly dispose of droppings in trash receptacles.
- Noisy, dangerous, intimidating, or destructive pets will not be allowed to remain in the park.
- Pet reptiles and birds must be confined or be under the physical control of the owner. Some animals may be prohibited on park property.

Failure to abide by these rules may result in the camper being asked to board the pet outside the park or to leave the campground. Immediately report any lost pet.
