

The Florida Conservation Corps (FLCC) program is administered by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection Florida Park Service with members serving at state parks throughout Florida. Members serving under FLCC Project A.N.T. (Americorps Nonnative plant Terminators) focus on habitat restoration through the management of invasive exotic plants. Members help to reduce invasive exetic plant infestations through various land management techniques and by recruiling valunteers from the community to help with this important restoration effort. Educating park visitors about the importance of Floridate ecosystems and Issues of Invasive exotic plants is also an important piece. Project A.N.T. members also assist with making trail improvements including maintaining trails for visitor use, developing vali interpretty and informational materials and conducting assessments of trail user accessibility and environmental impa You will not be able to specify your preferred placement at this time. part of Project A.N.T. (AmenCorps Non-native plant Terminators) focus on invasive exotic plant management and trail improvement in Florida's state parks. Members spend a majority of their time outdoors treating and removing invasive exotic plants, surveying for invasive exotic plants and performing trail improvements. Members use various techniques such as herbicide apraying and prescribed fine to reduce infestations. Members also recruit volunteers to assist with invasive exotic plant management, and educate park visitors and the local community about harm caused educate park ventre and the local community about name cases by invasive exotic plants. Additionally, Project A.N.T. members perform trail improvements by assisting with the maintenance of current trails, helping clear new trails, developing interpretive and informational materials and conducting trail user accessibility and environmental impact assessments. Service duties may as include classification, and any result in development. disaster relief, and may result in deployment.
