


The Florida Trail System in Jonathan Dickinson State Park

- Green Loop Trail - 4.9 miles
- White Loop Trail - 7.5 miles
- Ocean-to-Lake (Orange) Hike - 9.4 miles
- White Side Trail to Kitching Creek Campsite - 0.3 miles

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE RAILROAD TRACKS ARE NOT TO BE CROSSED EXCEPT ALONG THE OFFICIAL CROSSING ALONG PARK DRIVE



Scrub Jay and Kitching Creek Backpack Campsite Directions

From the Ranger Station:

Proceed in either direction on the GREEN trail; both choices lead to the Park Drive railroad crossing. Cross the tracks (***this is the only legal spot to cross the tracks***) and then take the WHITE trail, north or south, until you reach the ORANGE trail. Proceed west on the ORANGE trail to reach the Scrub Jay Campsite, and then further along the ORANGE trail, to the short WHITE connector trail, to the Kitching Creek Campsite.

From the Camp Murphy Trailhead:

Cross over the railroad tracks, and then take the WHITE trail, heading either north or south, until you reach the ORANGE trail. Proceed west on the ORANGE trail to reach the Scrub Jay Campsite, and then further along the ORANGE trail, to the short WHITE connector trail, to the Kitching Creek Campsite.
